



SAMPLE APPOINTMENT LETTER - RESIDENT

Dear Dr. [Last Name]:

We are very pleased to have you join us for your graduate medical education training at Texas A&M School of Medicine, Baylor Scott & White Medical Center - Temple, TX. This letter is your official Letter of Appointment as a PGY-1 Resident. This appointment is effective <u>July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024</u>. The 2023-2024 annual salary for a PGY-1 is \$58,240.

Please be advised that your continued appointment in your graduate medical education training is contingent upon satisfactory completion of training expectations, and adherence to institutional policies including "smoke/tobacco-free workplace, campus hiring policy" as well as the mandatory COVID and influenza vaccination policy. Additionally, you must have satisfactorily passed USMLE Steps 1 and 2, or its comparable examination, (i.e. COMLEX) to begin your residency appointment. It is required you document medical records and log your duty hours/approve your duty hours; all in an accurate, honest, and timely manner. Failure to comply with the duty hours' expectations may jeopardize your continued employment.

Texas A&M School of Medicine, Baylor Scott & White Medical Center - Temple sponsors only the J-1 visa for those individuals who require a visa to be work-authorized. Securing your J-1 visa is a requirement to begin your employment at Baylor Scott & White Medical Center - Temple.

Please be reminded that a satisfactory result of drug and nicotine screening is a condition of employment for <u>all</u> Baylor Scott & White employees. Employment is also contingent upon verification of educational credentials, passage of criminal background check and obtaining a **P**hysician **In-T**raining (PIT) Permit from the Texas Medical Board <u>or</u> a Full Medical License from the Texas Medical Board. Please note you will be <u>unable</u> to begin your clinical training without your PIT or Full Medical License.
